Laurence Matherson

From Melbourne, Laurence is a passionate pianist, Chamber Musician, accompanist and harpsichordist. In 2016 he was awarded an Australian National Academy of Music (ANAM) Fellowship. Laurence has performed multiple times at the Melbourne Recital Centre and is regularly broadcast on the Classic FM stations and is a prolific solo performer at Australia's major Chamber Music venues; also having performed as soloist with the Australian Ballet, Opera Australia, Melbourne Symphony Orchestra and Orchestra Victoria, winning many awards.

Stewart Kelly

One of Australia's finest piano collaborators, piano teachers and accompanists, soloist, Chamber Musician, Vocal accompanist and broadcaster, regularly performing around the country. In 2014 he was awarded a fellowship by ANAM Australia's most prestigious music training institution. Stewart is on the staff at the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music at Melbourne University and is a faculty member of the Victorian College of the Arts Secondary School.
